



CT STATE ASNUNTUCK STUDENT AMBASSADOR JOB DESCRIPTION

GOALS & OBJECTIVES

The Asnuntuck Student Ambassador program is a method for providing leadership experience for students and support for Asnuntuck functions. Student Ambassadors are offered opportunities to explore their leadership and service potential through the Student Ambassador program. Student Ambassadors serve in a variety of capacities and participate in opportunities unique and specific to the Asnuntuck campus.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Student Ambassador program, students must:

- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 after completing their first semester at ACC
- Continuing Education students must have at least a 70% average
- Participate in a mandatory interview with Student Ambassador Program advisors
- Maintain a good academic standing or a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75
- Have a willingness to be a student ambassador for at least one year
- Have the ability and desire to participate in on-campus events

Student Ambassadors must maintain a caring, service-orientated attitude with respect to the college and program objectives. This attitude is represented in willingness to attend program training and serve in capacities deemed appropriate by the program advisors.

CONDUCT

Student Ambassadors are student representatives of Asnuntuck. They welcome and enjoy unique leadership opportunities and advantages for personal advancement and professional development. Student Ambassadors are expected to conduct themselves as campus leaders, exhibiting the behavior of a college representative while on campus and on social media platforms. Student Ambassadors should hone excellent interpersonal and communication skills, have a desire to meet and greet campus visitors, and a willingness to assist campus guests.

COLLEGE DUTIES

Student Ambassadors perform various duties and services as a CT State Asnuntuck representative. Duties include, but are not limited to: attending mandatory onboarding orientation, leading ACC campus tours, representing the college in outreach capacities via email and phone, meeting and greeting campus visitors, attending and ushering events such as: Campus-wide Open House, New Student Orientation, and Fresh Check Day.

COMPENSATION

Student Ambassadors are a valued resource for CT State Asnuntuck. Each Student Ambassador will be compensated per event worked.
