

Students who wish to earn more than two associate degrees from CT State must receive approval from the Campus Dean of Faculty prior to a third program being added to their student record.

Additional degrees must meet the following criteria:

- *All program requirements must be met for each degree earned.*
 - *The additional degree must be 15 credits different from any other degree earned (three associate degrees are a minimum of 90 total credits, etc.).*
 - *The residency requirement of one-quarter (25%) of any complete degree must be met for any degree earned at Connecticut State Community College.*
 - *No two degrees can be a part of the same group of options under a parent degree.*
