

Selective Admissions Checklist

Steps to Successful Enrollment

- Learn more about your program:
ctstate.edu/selective-admissions
- Meet the requirements by the deadline date
 - If you will not meet the deadline date, apply as a General Studies major and work on your admissions requirements (meet with your Advisor)
- Complete the Selective Admissions Application for Admission
 - Sign in: ctstate.edu/admissions-apply
 - You may apply to more than one selective program, however, only one campus location may be chosen per selective admissions program.
- Submit/upload your documents to your Admissions Application
 - Proof of high school completion
 - Proof of health immunization (two doses of measles, mumps, rubella and varicella)
- Log into your Application Account to view your required supplemental items
- Transfer students: request official college transcripts for an official college transfer credit evaluation (transfer of previously earned credits)
 - Request transfer: ctstate-transcripteval@ct.edu
 - Send your transcript electronically from a verified service, such as Parchment (<https://www.parchment.com>)
- Complete the FAFSA (recommended)
 - <https://studentaid.gov>
- Check your application email address for an offer of admission. Sign in to ctstate.edu/admissions-apply to accept your offer (you may only accept one selective admissions program offer)
- Follow all instructions included in your “Accepted Student Packet”
