#### How to Apply for Graduation

All students who are ready to graduate must apply for graduation. Please log in to **myCTState** and then go to student self-service and apply for graduation. The application deadline for May 2025 conferrals is April 15, 2025.

#### **Caps and Gowns**

Students who will be graduating can pick up a cap and gown beginning Monday, May 12, 2025 at GRADFest in the Beacon Hall Event Center from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., and at the book store through May 21 during normal bookstore hours. A valid photo ID must be shown at pickup. There is no charge for caps and gowns.

#### Tickets

Tickets are needed to enter the amphitheater. Tickets will be handed out with your cap and gown graduation packet at GRADFest. Tickets are limited to six per student. Tickets are for graduates, family members and guests. There is no cost for tickets.

**Graduates must arrive by 8:30 a.m.** and all guests should come to the amphitheater by 9:00 a.m. and be prepared to go through the lines and the amphitheater's security procedures, including metal detectors or subject to a physical pat down. Large bags, backpacks, celebratory items such as balloons and other items, etc. are not allowed in the amphitheater. If you bring items that are not allowed, you will be asked to bring them back to your car or throw them away.

Please bring your name cards and tickets with you when you go to the amphitheater. The name card is for the reader to announce your name and then the card goes to the photographers. Please be sure to register with the photographer using the scan code on the card.

If you cannot attend GRADFest, you can pick up your cap and gown graduation packet from Follett Bookstore by May 21, 2025, during regular bookstore business hours.

Remember to take your gown out of the plastic bag and hang it up to take out the creases and wrinkles.

Invitations will be extended to students who have been recognized for an award and the specific award will be disclosed to the recipients during the Award Convocation.


Please be on the lookout at the beginning of May for an email sent to your college email address that will include an invitation and details about the night for awardees.

#### **Commencement Ceremony**

All graduates and guests who have chosen to be at and participate in the Commencement ceremony MUST stay for the entire ceremony. All guests can meet the graduates after the procession.



#### **Directions to the Amphitheater**

The amphitheater is accessible from Interstate 95 (I-95), Route 8 (Rt. 8), the Merritt Parkway (Rt. 15) and local roads. Due to heavy traffic, please allow extra time to arrive at the amphitheater. If you are using a map app, use 500 Broad Street, Bridgeport. If you need detailed directions, please see the amphitheater's website.

**Please note:** There will be heavy traffic in the area due to another campus graduation ceremony at the Total Mortgage Arena, which is located next to the amphitheater, being held on the same day and time. Graduates must arrive by 8:30 a.m.

#### Parking

Parking is available across the street from the amphitheater. Parking is also available in CT State Housatonic's parking garage. It is a short walk from the campus to the amphitheater.

#### **Disabled Parking Placard**

Limited accessible parking is available at the amphitheater. Show the parking staff your Disabality Parking Placard and they will direct you to the parking area. These spaces are available on a limited basis and are on a first-come, first-served basis. Once the spaces are full, the amphitheater staff will direct you to other parking lots.

#### **Arrival and Procession**

#### Graduates must arrive by 8:30 a.m.

Please allow extra time to get through the amphitheater security procedures, then proceed to the student check-in table in the tunnel for instructions and lineup.

All guests must arrive by 9:00 a.m. to be seated before the Processional begins at 9:45 a.m. Please allow extra time to get through the amphitheater's security procedures.

#### **Honor Cords**

Honor cords will be distributed at the student check-in table at the amphitheater before the ceremony to students with a GPA of 3.4 or higher. If you have Phi Theta Kappa or business honor sashes or cords, please bring them with you.

### Professional Photography of Your Special Day

A professional photographer will be available to take your photograph on the stage after receiving your diploma cover. Additional photographs will be taken when you exit the stage. You can order pictures from the photography company, register using the scan code on the name card.

#### Photography Taken by Family Members and Guests of Graduates

Guests are not permitted in the aisles to take photographs during the Commencement ceremony. This activity is prohibited by the Fire Marshall and such activity can be distracting and may create safety concerns. The amphitheater's policy allows camera phones, disposable cameras and small digital cameras. The amphitheater does not allow any professional cameras that have a detachable lens or a lens that zooms out of the camera more than one inch.

#### **Diploma Covers and Diploma Pick Up**
