Responsibilities of the SGA Senator

As stated in the SGA Constitution: Waterbury Senator

- 1. Shall present any and all proposals from the general student body they represent on the Waterbury Campus.
- 2. Total number of senators may not exceed the official number of club representatives at the SGA meetings.
- 3. Shall provide guidance in determining policies, which affect the student body.
- 4. Shall serve on at least one committee per semester on the Waterbury Campus.
