
*BOR policy requires prior approval for the following institutional actions regarding academic programming. (These proposals would continue to the CSCU Academic Council and the Board of Regents.)

- Above Threshold Establishment or Modification of a New Academic Program
- · Reinstatement of Discontinued or Suspended Program
- Continued Licensure and OHE Accreditation of an Academic Program
- Replication of a College of Technology (COT) Program
- Suspension of an Academic Program
- Discontinuation of an Academic Program
- Establishment of a CSCU Center/ Institute

Course proposals would complete the development & approval process with the CT State Provost/President.




Example: New Program Proposal

• If an initial (draft) new program proposal is submitted to an SDC for the Feb 3rd meeting,

the entire process could take approximately 6-7* weeks to navigate the CT State Shared Governance structure (from 2/3 through 3/24) before moving on to the CSCU Academic Council and BOR for final approval.



This timeline may, of course, take longer based on various factors that may delay the development or approval of a proposal along the way.

However, this 6-7 week timeline would be reasonable for a proposal that does not require significant changes or revisions after the SDC initiates the governance approval process.
