Modality

Instructional method of classes that students have registered for: Students taking only LRON (live remote and online) and ONLN (fully online) sections are classified as "All Remote;" students taking OLCR (online with class component) LRCR (live remote or on ground), HYBR (online and classroom), or FLEX sections, or taking any combination of fully online, partially online, or in-person classses are classified as "Some Remote;" all other students are classified as "All in-Person."

Race and Ethnicity

Students are grouped into race and ethnicity categories based on U.S. Office of Personnel Management classifications. Native Americans, Alaska Natives, Native Hawaiians, Pacific Islanders, students reporting two or more races and students not reporting their racial or ethnic identity are combined under "Various/Multiple/Unknown." U.S. Nonresidents are included in their chosen racial-ethnic group instead of recategorized as "Various/Multiple/Unknown."

Seats Filled

The sum of all section registrations by enrolled students

Student Type

"New First Time" students are enrolling for credit for the first time as postsecondary students; "Transfer-in" students have been enrolled for credit at a non-CT State institution but are enrolling here for the first time; "Continuing/Readmitted" students have previously enrolled at CT State for credit; "High School Dual Enrollment" students are secondary students taking college-level credit classes at a CT State location. Note: Expect year-over-year Transfer-in numbers to be down significantly as students who enroll at multiple CT State campuses will no longer be counted as transfers but rather as continuing or readmitted students.
