Note. There were two students with Std_type = E (Non-Credit) and three postsecondary students who identified as non-binary (Sex = N) in Fall 2023. They are included in the overall numbers and percentages but they are not disaggregated.

Summary

- For Fall 2023 Spring 2024, the overall retention rate is 72% excluding graduates and 75% including graduates.
- Part-time, transfer-in students have the highest transfer-out rates at 7%.
- Readmit students have the highest stop-out rates at (21% for full-time, readmit students and 40% for part-time, readmit students).
- Compared with part-time students, full-time students have a higher retention rate (82% excluding graduates and 85% including graduates for full-time students and 66% excluding graduates and 69% including graduates for part-time students) and a lower stop-out rate (13% for full-time students and 29% for part-time students).
- Female students and male students have about the same retention rate (72% excluding graduates and 75% including graduates for female students and 71% excluding graduates and 74% including graduates for male students).
- Female students and male students have the same transfer-out rates at 2%.
- The Fall 2023 Spring 2024 retention rates among campuses range from 69% to 76% excluding graduates and from 71% to 81% including graduates.

Methodological Notes

- Students who completely withdrew (Hrs_Crd_Sem = 0) are excluded.
- Secondary students (Std_type = 0 (CCP (TP)) and 1 (Secondary, Non CCP (TP))) are excluded.
- Students who audited a class or classes are included.
- Unknown includes Ethnic_New_Desc = No Response and Not Hispanic or Latino and Race_New_Desc = null values.
- Correctional facilities are linked to campuses. Specifically, Quinebaug Valley includes Campus = XBR; Middlesex includes Campus = XCH; Housatonic includes Campus = XGR; Three Rivers includes Campus = XCR, XMN, and XYK, and Asnuntuck includes Campus = XMW, XOB, XRB, and XWC.
- Removed Record = N, College Name = Capital Community College, and Enrollment Status = W (Withdrawn) from National Student Clearinghouse StudentTracker Detailed Report.
