Summary

- For Spring 2023 Fall 2023, the overall retention rate is 57% excluding graduates and 68% including graduates.
- Transfer-in students have the highest transfer-out rates (13% for full-time, transfer-in students and 16% for part-time, transfer-in students).
- Readmit students have the highest stop-out rates at (35% for full-time, readmit students and 49% for part-time, readmit students).
- Compared with part-time students, full-time students have a higher retention rate (65% excluding graduates and 79% including graduates for full-time students and 54% excluding graduates and 64% including graduates for part-time students) and a lower stop-out rate (15% for full-time students and 31% for part-time students).
- Female students have a slightly higher retention rate than male students (58% excluding graduates and 70% including graduates for female students and 56% excluding graduates and 66% including graduates for male students).
- Female students and male students have about the same transfer-out rates (5% for female students and 6% for male students).
- The Spring 2023 Fall 2023 retention rates among campuses range from 52% to 61% excluding graduates and from 65% to 71% including graduates.

Summary

- For Fall 2022 Fall 2023, the overall retention rate is 46% excluding graduates and 59% including graduates.
- Transfer-in students have the highest transfer-out rates (10% for full-time, transfer-in students and 16% for part-time, transfer-in students).
- Readmit students have the highest stop-out rates at (44% for full-time, readmit students and 56% for part-time, readmit students).
- Compared with part-time students, full-time students have a higher retention rate (53% excluding graduates and 69% including graduates for full-time students and 41% excluding graduates and 53% including graduates for part-time students) and a lower stop-out rate (25% for full-time students and 40% for part-time students).
- Female students have a slightly higher retention rate than male students (46% excluding graduates and 60% including graduates for female students and 45% excluding graduates and 57% including graduates for male students).
- Female students and male students have the same transfer-out rates (7% for female students and 7% for male students).
- The Fall 2022 Fall 2023 retention rates among campuses range from 38% to 49% excluding graduates and from 55% to 62% including graduates.

Methodological Notes

- Students who completely withdrew (Hrs_Crd_Sem = 0) are excluded.
- Secondary students (Std_type = 0 (CCP (TP)) and 1 (Secondary, Non CCP (TP))) are excluded.
- The disaggregation by Enrollment Status, Student Type, and Campus includes duplicate student records due to concurrent enrollment.
- Students who audited a class or classes are included.
- Other Race/Ethnicity includes Ethnic_New_Desc = No Response or Not Hispanic or Latino and Race_New_Desc = American Indian or Alaska Native, DO NOT USE Other, or Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander.
- Unknown includes Ethnic_New_Desc = No Response or Not Hispanic or Latino and Race_New_Desc = DO NOT USE Choose Not to Respond or null values.
- Removed Record = N, College Name = [All Legacy Connecticut Community Colleges], and Enrollment Status = W (Withdrawn) from National Student Clearinghouse StudentTracker Detailed Reports.
