### Summary

- For Spring 2024 – Fall 2024, the overall retention rate is 60% excluding graduates and 71% including graduates.
- Transfer-in students have the highest transfer-out rates (12% for full-time, transfer-in students and 16% for part-time, transfer-in students).
- Readmit students have the highest stop-out rates at (35% for full-time, readmit students and 46% for part-time, readmit students).
- Compared with part-time students, full-time students have a higher retention rate (66% excluding graduates and 80% including graduates for full-time students and 57% excluding graduates and 67% including graduates for part-time students) and a lower stop-out rate (14% for full-time students and 29% for part-time students).
- Female students have a slightly higher retention rate than male students (61% excluding graduates and 72% including graduates for female students and 58% excluding graduates and 69% including graduates for male students).
- Female students and male students have about the same transfer-out rates (5% for female students and 6% for male students).
- The Spring 2024 – Fall 2024 retention rates among campuses range from 57% to 63% excluding graduates and from 68% to 76% including graduates.

### Summary

- For Fall 2023 – Fall 2024, the overall retention rate is 49% excluding graduates and 62% including graduates.
- Transfer-in students have the highest transfer-out rates (11% for full-time, transfer-in students and 17% for part-time, transfer-in students).
- Readmit students have the highest stop-out rates at (33% for full-time, readmit students and 49% for part-time, readmit students).
- Compared with part-time students, full-time students have a higher retention rate (54% excluding graduates and 71% including graduates for full-time students and 47% excluding graduates and 58% including graduates for part-time students) and a lower stop-out rate (23% for full-time students and 36% for part-time students).
- Female students have a higher retention rate than male students (50% excluding graduates and 64% including graduates for female students and 47% excluding graduates and 60% including graduates for male students).
- Female students and male students have about the same transfer-out rates (6% for female students and 7% for male students).
- The Fall 2023 – Fall 2024 retention rates among campuses range from 46% to 52% excluding graduates and from 59% to 70% including graduates.

## Methodological Notes

- Students who completely withdrew (Hrs\_Crd\_Sem = 0) are excluded.
- Secondary students (Std\_type = 0 (CCP (TP)) and 1 (Secondary, Non CCP (TP))) are excluded.
- Students who audited a class or classes are included.
- Other Race/Ethnicity includes Ethnic\_New\_Desc = No Response or Not Hispanic or Latino and Race\_New\_Desc = American Indian or Alaska Native, Middle East Region, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, or North African Saharan/Mediterranean.
- Unknown includes Ethnic\_New\_Desc = No Response or Not Hispanic or Latino and Race\_New\_Desc = null values.
- Removed Record = N, College Name = CONNECTICUT STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE - [All Campuses], and Enrollment Status = W (Withdrawn) from National Student Clearinghouse StudentTracker Detailed Reports.
