Dr. Jamonica Rolle is a distinguished academic leader with over 20 years of experience in teaching and administration. She currently serves as College Provost and Senior Vice President of Academic Affairs and College Operations (Interim) at Broward College, a role she has held since July 2024. Throughout her tenure, she has held key leadership roles including Vice Provost of Academic Affairs and North Campus, Dean of Academic Affairs and Associate Dean of Communication & Fine Arts.

Before transitioning into senior leadership, Dr. Rolle served as a full-time faculty member in Speech Communication at Broward College. Her teaching background also includes positions as a Graduate Business Communication Instructor at Florida Atlantic University and a high school English and Reading teacher in Broward County Public Schools.

Dr. Rolle has led major institutional initiatives focused on student success, academic excellence, and strategic partnerships. She played a key role in Broward College's recent accreditation reaffirmation and is currently leading the transition to a new institutional accrediting body. Her efforts have driven reforms in developmental education, strengthened student and faculty engagement, and expanded community and workforce partnerships. As Vice President for the North Campus, she built lasting collaborations with municipal, community, and industry leaders.

She holds a B.A. and M.A. in Communication from Florida Atlantic University and an Ed.D. in Higher Education Administration from the University of Florida. Dr. Rolle serves on the Board of Directors for 211 Broward, the American Association of Community Colleges Commission on Student Success, the Pompano Beach Economic Development Council, and two local chambers of commerce.
