ELIGIBILITY REINSTATEMENT FORM FOR THE FEDERAL STUDENT LOAN PROGRAM AFTER PREVIOUS TOTAL AND PERMANENT DISABILITY DISCHARGE

This form is not necessary if you are only seeking a Federal Pell Grant.

This form serves to reestablish your eligibility for the Federal Student Loan Program when prior loans have been discharged due to a total and permanent disability. To be eligible to receive Federal Student loans the Borrower Acknowledgement form must be signed and submitted along with a letter from a licensed physician certifying your ability to engage in substantial gainful activity. Loans will not be processed until both requirements have been satisfied.

The borrower acknowledgement form must be completed each time a new loan is requested. Completion of the form does not guarantee eligibility for the Federal Student Loan Program.

Please note: There is a 3-year monitoring period for borrowers who have been granted a Total and Permanent Disability Discharge. If a borrower requests a new loan within the 3-year monitoring period, payments on previously discharged loans will resume. Physician Certification

In addition to signing the Borrower Acknowledgement, a signed letter from a licensed physician must also be provided. The letter must be from a physician who has provided treatment for the disability and certifies that you are able to engage in substantial gainful activity (a level of work performed for pay that involves doing significant physical or mental activities or a combination of both) as defined by the U.S. Department of Education.
