This document must be completed, signed, and submitted to CT State Community College before an admitted student may be issued a Form I-20. Affidavit and financial documents must be less than six (6) months old at the time of applying.

DECLARATION OF FINANCES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

CT State Community College is required by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) to ensure that all applicants can pay all charges and living expenses while studying at CT State without having to engage in work. The amount below must be proven before the issuance of a Form I-20

Tuition, Books, and Living Expenses: \$22,520

If you are bringing immediate family members (spouse or children), you are required to show an additional \$3,500 per dependent.

Students receiving free room and board are *not* required to show funds for living expenses (\$7,000).
